



## Wheeler Pride Marching Band Program Costs and Dues

<b>Cost to each marching student:</b>	<b>\$1,200</b>
May 20 – Commitment Fee	\$ 100
June 15 – First Installment	\$ 275
July 15 – Second Installment	\$ 275
August 15 – Third Installment	\$ 275
September 15 – Fourth Installment	\$ 275

### What your \$1,200 covers...

- Marching Band
- Band Camp (transportation, room and board, instruction, parties)
- Marching Uniform
- Show design, licensing fees and props
- T-Shirt
- Additional instructional staff for marching, clinics and symphonic band camp
- Transportation to camp, games, performances, competitions, Festival
- Competition fees
- Water, first aid, etc. at marching practices and events
- Occasional meals during long practices
- Classroom band fee
- Classroom band uniform (tux or gown)
- Festival
- Most parties and social events

### What all this actually costs...

**\$2,000. This would be the estimated cost to each student without the fund-raising activities of our booster club.**

Fund-raising by the Wildcat Pride Booster Club students and parents keeps the cost to individual students low, subtracting about \$800 of the total program cost from each student’s fees each year.

In addition, as a Booster member, you can add “thank-you” credits directly to your account through fund-raiser sales such as Indian River fruit and volunteer programs such as Papa John’s Pizza at the Georgia Dome and Bingo at the local VFW.
